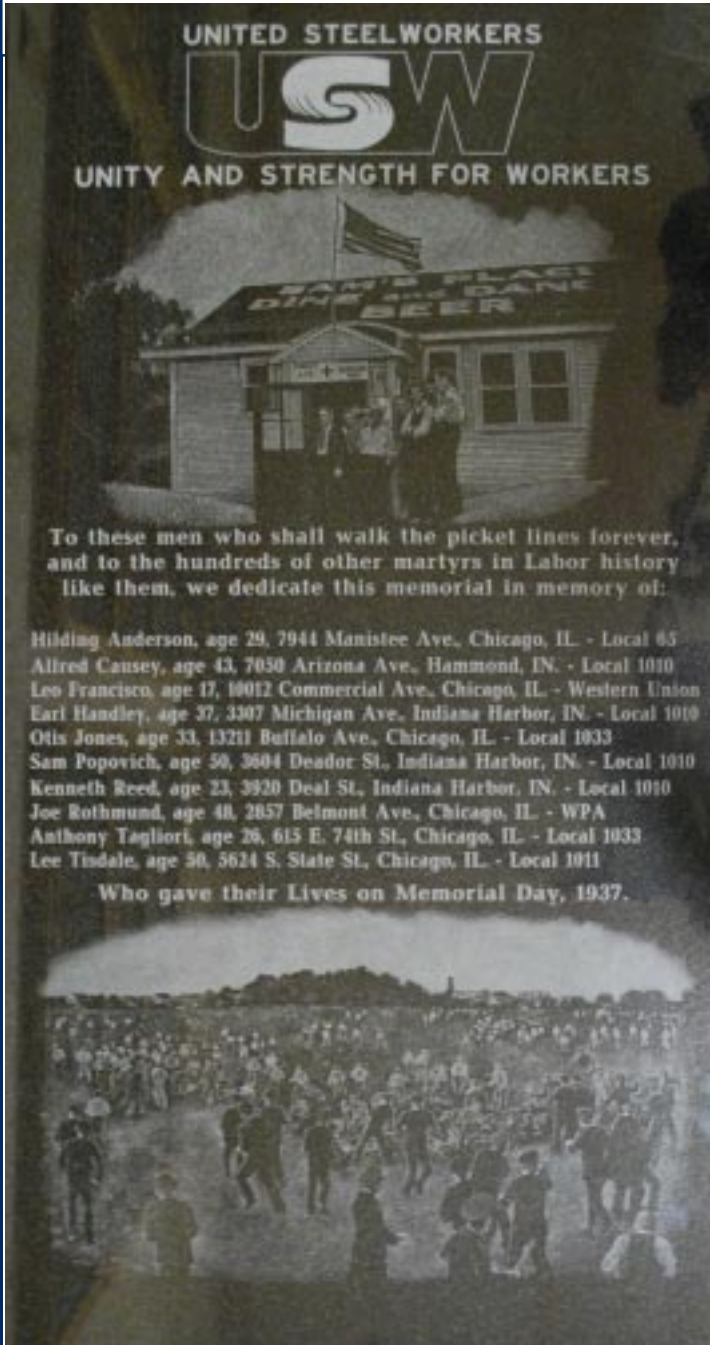

Our local has a proud history of setting the pace for change within the Steelworkers Union.

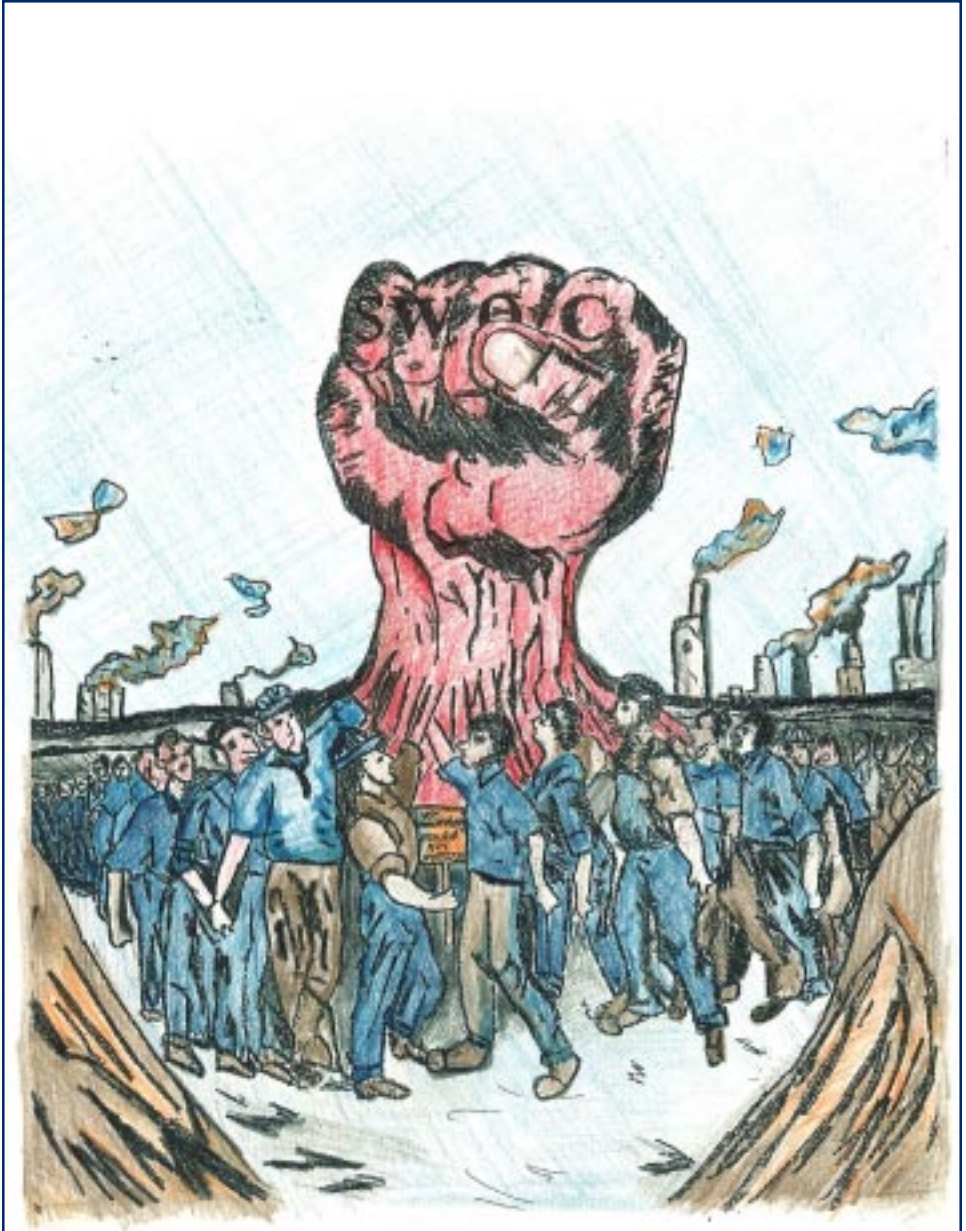
The history of the United Steelworkers Local 1010 would not be complete without mentioning something about the people, to whom this history is dedicated, who have been and are Local 1010.

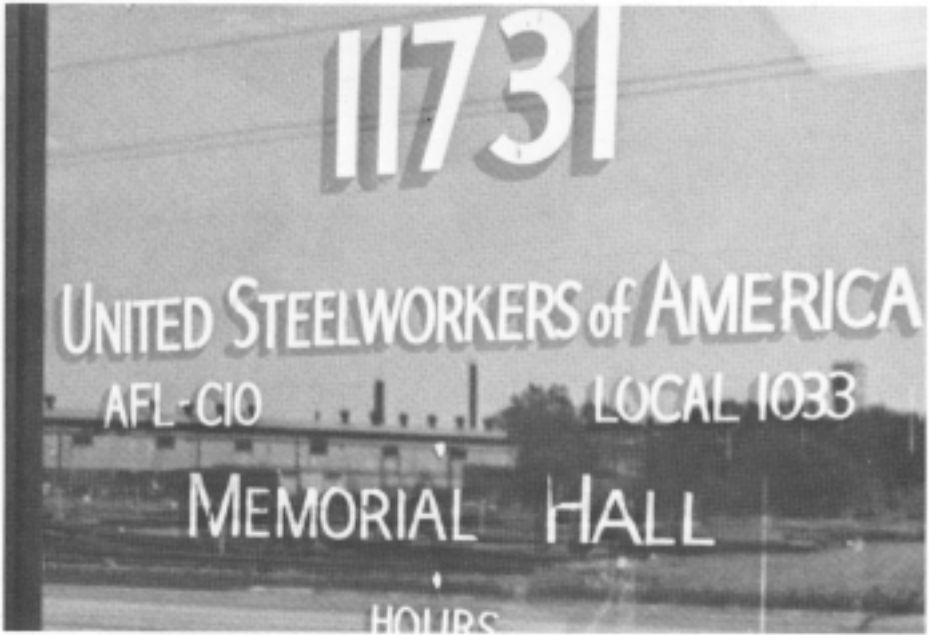
